• <u>Intergovernmental Agreement and Designating Ordinance Amendment #8 for Peoria Urban Enterprise Zone</u>

A motion to approve was made by Mr. Salzer and seconded by Ms. Groves Allison. Mr. Sorrel remarked that the Peoria Urban Enterprise Zone Designating Ordinance has an underlying Intergovernmental Agreement with participating counties and municipalities; in this instance the municipalities being the City of Peoria, Village of Peoria Heights, City of West Peoria, Village of Bartonville, and Village of Mapleton. He advised that Amendment #8 reflects boundary changes

as well as changes to the Designating Ordinance to reflect modification of eligibility criteria data per state statute. He explained the eligibility criteria amendments and presented a detailed summary of the various boundary amendments.

The motion to approve carried unanimously.

• Rural Broadband Contract Award

A motion to approve was made by Mr. Rieker and seconded by Dr. Blair. Mr. Sorrel commented that one of the County Board's stated priorities for American Rescue Plan Act funding is rural broadband. He advised that a grant received in 2022 was used for an initial planning session, with a recommendation coming from that session to implement an engineering study to determine detailed information as to the areas within the county in need of high speed access in rural areas. He stated that in conjunction with the Economic Development Council, an RFP was prepared, and after a review and evaluation of the respondents, staff recommends awarding the consultant services contract to Design Nine of Blackburn, VA. He stated that the total cost includes \$68,535.00 in professional services and \$37,358.00 in postage and associated costs for a residential survey. He commented that funding has been appropriated for this purpose from ARPA funds and no budget amendment is necessary.

The motion to approve carried unanimously.
